Thank you for purchasing ultra-thin Bluetooth headset Q6. Smooth touching, easy operation and fashionable design make it the best choice for you. Prior to using the headset, it is recommended to fully charge the headset and pair it with your Bluetooth devices.

1. Q6 Bluetooth Headset Overview

- ①. LED Indicator
- ②. Volume+/Previous track
- ③. Volume-/Next track
- ④. Speaker
- ⑤. Microphone
- ⑥. Charging Socket
- ⑦. MFB

2. Charging Your Headset

The LED will be red when charging. Once the battery is fully charged, the red LED will turn off. It takes 2 hours to fully charge the headset. (Operation and charging can be done simultaneously) If paired with iPhone, the battery capacity can be indicated on upper right corner of iPhone.

3. Pairing Your Headset

In off status, press and hold the MFB for 3 seconds, the Red&Blue indicator lights for 1 second and the Blue indicator flash for one time. After you hear "Power On" and "Du" tone with "Pairing" voice prompt, it enters pairing status.

Subsequent pairing:

- ①. Active Bluetooth function of your mobile phone.
- ②. Select "More" in the "New Pairing Devices" and search for "Q3" model.
- ③. Press "OK" in your mobile phone and enter PIN code "0000" to pairing it.

Note: Manual operation is needed for some devices though after pairing completed. It is not necessary to enter the code if your mobile phone Bluetooth version is 2.1 or higher.

4. Successful Connection

If the headset connects with your mobile successfully, you can hear "Connected" voice prompt.

When your headset is away from the mobile phone, it will disconnect with voice prompt "Apart already".

(Connection is not finished within 10 minutes, it will shut down automatically in 5 minutes.)

Connect automatically: when the mobile phone Bluetooth function is re-opened after disconnected or turned off, click the MFB once and it will connect automatically with "connected" voice prompt.

When headset is disconnected with the mobile phone, you will hear "Disconnected" voice prompt. (Shut down automatically if not connected within 5 minutes)

5. Multi-point Connection

Method 1:

Turn off the headset after successfully connected with current mobile phone. Turn on the headset again to pair it with another mobile phone. After successfully connected with another mobile phone, please find the pairing record from the first mobile phone and active the history pairing by mobile phone.

Method 2:

Turn off the headset after successfully connected with current mobile phone. Turn on the headset again to pair it with another mobile phone. Disconnect it after successfully connected with another mobile phone. Turn on the headset again to pair it automatically with 2 devices simultaneously.

6. Using Your Headset

Answer a call

— When call is coming, you will hear voice prompt "Call Coming" with the caller ID broadcast, easily speak "YES" or press the MFB to answer the call

Reject a call

— When a call is coming, use your voice "No" or press and hold the MFB for 2 seconds with two "DU" tone to reject it.

Call Mute

— During the call, double click the MFB to mute the call, with "Mute" voice prompt. (Repeat to return)

Transfer a call

— During the call, press and hold the MFB for 2 seconds with "Du" tone to transfer the call to your mobile phone. (Repeat to return)

Ending a Call:

— During the talk, click the MFB to end the call and you can hear "Du" tone.

Reject the third party call:

— During a call, when a third party call in, double-click the MFB till hear a "Du" tone and release it to reject and keep the present talk.

Answer the third party and hang up the current call

— During a call, when a third party call in, you can click the MFB once till hear "Du" tone and release to answer a third party call and hang up the present conversation.

Answer the third party and hold the current call

— During a call, press and hold the MFB until "Du" tone to answer the third party call and keep the present call on

Voice Dialing

— In stand-by mode, press and hold the MFB for 2s and you can hear "Du" tone and speak the name, prior to use this function, please record voice via the headset first.

Last Call Redialing

— In stand-by mode, double click the MFB to redial the last call you have dialed.

Volume Adjusting

— Adjust the volume by volume keys of "+"&"-".

Note: Adjust volume appropriately, too high volume may harm your hearing.

Paly/Pause

— In music status, click the MFB to pause. Repeat to return to music.

Previous track

— In music status, long press volume key "+" for 2 seconds to play the previous song.

Next Track

— In music status, long press volume key "-" for 2 seconds to play the next song.

Reset Function

— Charging your headset to reset when buttons are not working.

Wearing Style

— You can wear the headset either with ear-hook or without ear-hook, on your left or right ear.

Troubleshooting

If you are unable to connect your headset and mobile phone, please try the following:

- Ensure your headset is turned off and is properly charged.
- Ensure the headset is paired with your mobile phone.
- Ensure your mobile phone's Bluetooth feature is activated. Please refer to your mobile phone user guide for specific instruction.
- Ensure the headset is within a 10 meters range of your mobile phone and there are no obstructions, such as walls or other electronic devices in between.
- If the above steps do not solve your problem, please recharge the headset and remove your mobile phone battery for a short time.

Safely Information

- Please correct use mobile phone and headset according to the local law while driving. If you use the headset while driving, ensure your attention and focus remains on the road and you drive in a responsible and safe manner.
- Never allow children to play with the headset small parts may be suffocating.
- Observe all signs that require an electrical device or RF radio product to be switched off in designated areas.

These could include hospitals, blasting areas, and potentially explosive environments.

- Turn off your headset prior to boarding an aircraft. Do not use your headset in an aircraft.
- Never hang or store over any air bag development area as serious injury may result when the air bag deploys.
- Do not open or mutilate the built-in battery.
- Dispose of batteries according to local regulations. Do not dispose as household Waste.

Care and Maintenance Headset

- Consider turning your headset off before placing it in your pocket or bag. If the MFB is accidentally activated, your mobile phone may place an unintended call.
- Do not expose the headset to liquid, moisture or humidity as it is not waterproof.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning solvents to clean the headset.
- Do not expose the headset to extreme temperature conditions. The best store temperature range is from -10 to +60, otherwise the life of the headset will be influenced.
- Do not dispose of the headset in a fire as it may result in an explosion.
- Do not bring your headset into contact with sharp objects as this will cause scratched and damage.
- Do not attempt to disassemble the headset as it does not contain serviceable components.
- If you do not use the headset for long periods, be sure to store it in a dry place, free from extreme temperature conditions and dust.
